2006 NCAA DIVISION III SWIMMING AND DIVING GENERAL INFORMATION

SWIMMING POOL

The University of Minnesota Aquatic Center is located at 1925 University Avenue SE; Minneapolis, Minnesota, 55455; 612/626-1352 (see enclosed diagram).

TRAINING ROOM/HEALTH SERVICES

The Physician/Trainer's room is located behind the team seating area on the south side of the pool. The entry is near the starting block end of the pool. An athletic trainer will be on site during all practice and competition sessions to provide first aid and monitor equipment. Student-athletes who require rehabilitation and treatment modalities such as ultrasound and electric stimulation should bring a prescription from their team physician or athletic trainer. Ice will be available on deck throughout the meet. The local hospital is the University of Minnesota Medical Center, located at 500 Harvard Street, Minneapolis, Minnesota, 55455.

Coaches are asked to duplicate the enclosed medical information sheet and provide it to every student-athlete. Student-athletes are asked to complete the form and keep it with them in the event treatment is needed at the championships.

LOCKER ROOMS

There is limited locker room space at the Aquatic Center. We suggest that student-athletes come to the venue dressed to compete. There are two lockers rooms, each with 150 half lockers, and eight showerheads. Both locker rooms will be gender specific to the championship weekend.

VALUABLES

Carleton College, the University of Minnesota Aquatic Center and the NCAA assume no responsibility for the loss of personal articles. Each competitor, coach and spectator will be responsible for his or her own property.

TICKET INFORMATION

Tickets for the championships may be purchased at the door. Seating is on a first-come, first-served basis. Reserved seating is not available. All-session passes may only be pre-purchased by team members' families the Wednesday before the championships with the ticket order form supplied in this packet. Pre-sales will occur in the lobby of the Aquatic Center.

Participating coaches and allowable team representatives may be admitted to the pool deck via deck passes. Deck passes must be purchased at the meet registration table. Student-athlete passes will be supplied in the coach's packet.

TEAM SEATING

Team seating will be selected at the coaches meeting (Wednesday at 3:30 p.m.). Seating assignments will be based on top ten (10) finish from the 2005 Championships.

SIGNAGE

Each team may provide ONE institutional banner to the Aquatic Center's staff. Banners will be assessed for appropriateness and compliance with Aquatic Center policy and hung by the Aquatic Center staff.

VIDEOTAPING

Coaches wishing to videotape performances should plan on doing so on battery power only. **Coaches** will not be allowed to plug in any cameras or battery chargers in the natatorium.

RESULTS

Finals results of each session's competition will be posted on concourse windows. Copies will be available for coaches in the school mail slots located behind the head table. A championships Web page will be available with daily results, team scores and a daily recap. The names of the top three finishers in each event and the top ten team scores will be sent to the Associated Press.

MERCHANDISE

During the championships, souvenir T-shirts and other meet merchandise will be on sale in the lobby of the Aquatic Center at the Gold Country kiosk.

CONCESSIONS

A concession stand offering food and beverages will be located in the lobby area of the Aquatic Center.

2006 NCAA DIVISION III SWIMMING AND DIVING MEET INFORMATION

ENTRY PROCEDURES

Swimming and diving entries must be submitted online by 11:59 p.m. Mountain time, Monday, February 20, for the women's championships and Monday, February 27, for the men's championships. Entry procedures were sent to the head coach and director of athletics in early February. Divers must also be listed on the online entry form.

Proof-of-performance (POP) forms must be faxed to Michelle Chaffin, NCAA Entry Coordinator, at 720/259-4115. Forms must be received by Ms. Chaffin no later than 11:59 p.m. Mountain time, Monday, February 20 for women and Monday, February 27 for men.

New this year: Divers must submit a POP form for <u>each</u> qualifying performance. A diving POP form must include the applicable diving score sheet(s).

Specific dates and times for information availability are as follows:

- <u>List of Teams</u>. A list of teams for which entry forms have been received will be posted at www.ncaa.org by 5 p.m. Eastern time **Wednesday**, **February 22**, for the women's championships, and **Wednesday**, **March 1**, for the men's championships.
- Entries. An unofficial list of all entries received will be posted at www.ncaa.org by 10 a.m. Eastern time **Thursday**, **February 23**, for the women's championships, and **Thursday**, **March 2**, for the men's championships. All relay entrant names will be referenced on this list. This will be a straight listing of data received and will NOT include estimated selection times per event. Coaches are asked to review the data for errors and report such errors to Ms. Chaffin by 5 p.m. Eastern time on the dates referenced above.
- Official Psyche Sheets. The official psyche sheets, including alternates and divers, will be posted at www.ncaa.org by noon Eastern time **Friday**, **February 24**, for the women's championships and **Friday**, **March 3**, for the men's championships. Alternates will be added to the championships in rank order from the alternate list as selected student-athletes become unavailable to compete.

An official psyche sheet and meet program will be included in each team's registration materials. Heat sheets for the following day's competition will be available on a limited basis Wednesday after dinner and before the completion of the Thursday and Friday finals.

OPTIONAL ENTRIES

Optional entries in individual events will be accepted until the entry deadline and must submitted via the online entry process. Any institution that has four swimmers who have qualified for the meet may enter any of the five relays. Relay-only swimmers may swim optional entries in a maximum of three (3) individual events if a B-time standard has been achieved in the respective event. For additional information, refer to the 2006 NCAA Division III Swimming and Diving Championship's Handbook.

CONFIRMATION

Upon arrival at the University of Minnesota Aquatic Center, the coach or an official representative from the institution must register and pick up an entry list and other pertinent championships materials. The coach or representative must sign an official receipt form indicating a correct entry of the individual/team as listed on the entry list. The registration desk will be located in the Radisson Hotel Metrodome. Registration hours are listed on the meet schedule.

DECK PASSES

Deck passes will be issued to institutional personnel (e.g., coaches, assistant coaches, official representatives, athletic trainers and managers) who have fulfilled a role with the institution's swimming and/or diving program on a regular basis throughout the season and who will be on the deck in a working/coaching capacity. A limited number of additional deck passes may be purchased by institutional personnel. The allocation of deck passes is based on the number of student-athletes participating for each institution. An institution with one to eight participants will be issued one deck pass and have the opportunity to purchase up to two additional passes. An institution with nine or more participants will be issued two deck passes and have the opportunity to purchase up to four additional passes. Please note that an institution with at least one swimmer and one diver will be issued two deck passes (i.e., a second pass for a second coach) and have the opportunity to purchase additional deck passes based on the total number of participants. Institutional personnel who purchase deck passes must also purchase a ticket for admittance. Payment for the permissible additional passes must be made on site at the registration desk by cash or check payable to Carleton College. The additional passes will be \$5.00 each. Coaches and/or student-athletes who lose deck passes will be charged the cost of an all-sessions pass for a replacement.

Institutional personnel authorized to have deck passes must conspicuously display the passes at all times. Anyone on deck without a pass will be asked to leave immediately—no exceptions.

Deck passes are non-transferable. Institutions that provide deck passes to unauthorized personnel during the championships will be fined \$100.

SCRATCH DEADLINE

Scratches are to be made by the coach or official representative by depositing scratch slips in the scratch box by the designated deadlines. A receipt form will be used for scratch verification. All entries not scratched will become official entries. Each diving coach or official representative must also submit a list of dives by the scratch deadline.

The scratch box will be accessible on the pool deck starting at 10 a.m., Wednesday, March 8 and 15. Please check the meet schedule for complete times and locations. Scratch deadlines are as follows:




