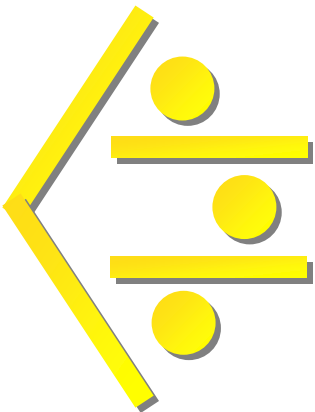
**REBECCA

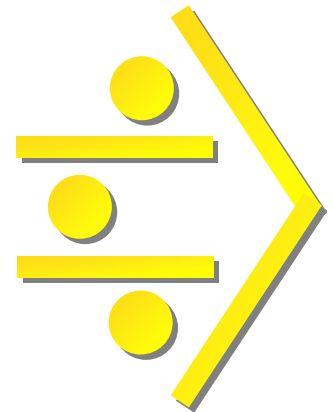
**ANNE
