- Northfield Transit offers service around the City from 8:30AM to 4:30PM every weekday and 10:00AM to 1:00PM on Saturday. Make sure to call at least two hours in advance. Their phone number is 507-645-7250. Pick up at Carleton is in front of Sayles.

Taxi vouchers

- Carleton is running a trial program that makes taxi vouchers for within Northfield available to students working on ACE projects.
- In order to get vouchers, fill out an online form and pick them up at the information desk in Sayles. Form link: <https://apps.carleton.edu/campus/services/acerequest/>
- Vouchers are for door-to-door service one-way. Each student needs a voucher even when sharing a cab, and you must call 1-24 hours in advance to arrange a ride. The number for Taxi First Choice is 507-645-4447.
