- Start with an idea (one that is creative, personally significant, and feasible) which involves travel abroad.
- Since the primary emphasis of the program is on its international experience rather than its academic aspect, formal study at foreign institutions will not be funded. Field work or research is appropriate, as long as it brings the Fellow into meaningful contact with a culture or society.
- Special consideration is given to those who demonstrate strong leadership potential.
- Students studying any discipline are eligible.
- Programs are supported in any country except for the United States and Canada.
- Students should design interesting projects that put them in touch with new people and cultures.
