Internship Requirements

Housing in a Carleton Co-op, \$350 a month for rent and utilities, June and July (dates can be flexible)

20 hours a week interning for a local non-profit

5 of these hours will be research on similar movements and relationships in Minnesota

20 hours working in a part-time job (or spending this time however you choose)

2 hours a week gardening

Participation in a weekly 1 hour reflection and group discussion

Final Group Service Project (to be announced/minimum time commitment)
