Some Rules

- Study at a non-accredited language institute will NOT be eligible for Carleton credit. However, many students find it useful when seeking to improve their language skills. When choosing one of these institutes, either in the U.S. or abroad, look for:
 - ✓ small classes
 - ✓ number of classroom interaction per day (minimum 4-5 hours/day)
 - ✓ daily practice with instructors and students
 - ✓ instruction in cultural context
 - ✓ language assistants/tutors
 - ✓ out-of-classroom activities with native speakers using target language
 - ✓ homestays or dorm arrangements with native speakers

 - College Year in Athens:** intensive Modern Greek, multi-level
 - NYU in Athens:** elementary and intermediate Modern Greek
- **Hungarian:**
 - Lexia in Budapest:** multi-level
- **Italian:**
 - U of Georgia in Cortona:** beginning
 - NYU in Florence:** elementary and intermediate
 - Lexia in Rome and Venice:** multi-level
 - IES Milan, Rome:** beginning to advanced plus area studies
- **Norwegian:**
 - U of Oslo International Summer School in Norway:** multi-level language plus Norwegian and Scandinavian history, literature, and culture
- **Polish:**
 - Lexia in Krakow:** multi-level

- **Portuguese:**
 - CIEE in Portugal:** multi-level
 - CIEE in Salvador da Bahia (Brazil):** 4 semesters of college-level Spanish or equivalent and/or 2 semesters of college-level Portuguese or equivalent
- **Korean:**
 - Yonsei University summer session:** multi-level; plus courses in variety of disciplines taught in English
- **Multi-language:**
 - SOAS (School of Oriental and African Studies) in London:** courses in Arabic, Amharic, Armenian, Bengali, Burmese, Chinese, Hausa, Hebrew, Hindi, Indonesian, Japanese, Korean, Kurdish, Malay, Nepali, Pashto, Persian, Swahili, Tamil, Thai, Tibetan, Turkish, Urdu, Vietnamese, and Zulu

Language Schools not eligible for Carleton credit:

- **Beloit Center for Language Studies:** summer intensive language and culture program in Russian, Japanese, Chinese, and Arabic
- **Goethe Institute, Berlin:** German, multi-level
- **Middlebury Language Schools:** Arabic, Chinese, French, German, Hebrew, Italian, Japanese, Portuguese, Russian, and Spanish
- **Monterey Institute:** Chinese, Russian, Arabic, Japanese, French, and Spanish
