



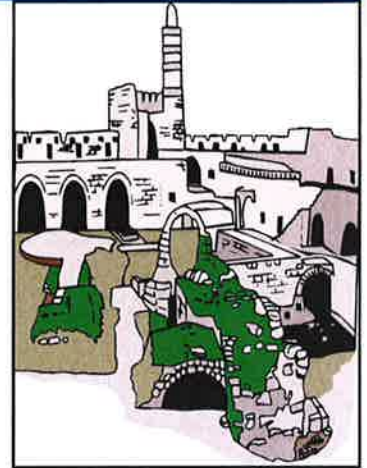

Eligibility: All Carleton students in good academic standing irrespective of religious affiliation or knowledge of Hebrew; and students who demonstrate a genuine interest in the history, language, and culture of Israel. The precise amount of scholarships will depend on the travel budgets of the proposals, as well as the number and quality of proposals received.

Application Process:

- A letter explaining the educational experiences that have prepared you for the study in Israel and ways in which this off-campus experience will contribute to your education.
- Two reference forms from faculty (available on Web or in LDC 230)
- Student application form (available on Web or in LDC 230)
- Submit **three** copies of all materials

Note: *Although a firm choice of a specific educational program is not required at the time of application, students are advised to explore study options in Israel with Professor Yaron Klein, Assistant Professor of Arabic, LDC 262, x5178, before applying.*

Deadline: *All materials must be submitted by 4:00 pm on Monday, February 20, 2012 to Jean Sherwin, Middle Eastern Languages Department, LDC 230.*
