

## **Resolution Concerning Program On Intergroup Relations**

Whereas the CSA Senate seeks to improve the campus climate at Carleton in order to promote a high quality of life for all students; and

Whereas the Senate understands dialogue and education around diversity to be central to the improvement of campus climate;

Whereas, following the approval of the “Resolution Concerning Retention Rates,” the Senate pursues institutional actions to specifically address the campus climate for students of color

*Resolved*, the Senate supports the adoption of a pilot program based on the University of Michigan’s Program for Intergroup Relations for the 2009-2010 school year for first year students; and

*Resolved*, through its liaisons to the Education and Curriculum Committee and other bodies, the Senate will work on behalf of the implementation of a permanent program for first year students following assessment of the aforesaid pilot program; and

*Resolved*, the Senate will urge the College to make said program a requirement for all first year students
