Resolved, all Senate committees and working groups will be given a charge by the CSA president detailing their objectives; and

Resolved, all Senate committees and working groups should set submit every other week progress reports to the CSA President detailing all material discussed and progress towards specified objectives and charges; and

Resolved, all such progress reports should be made public with the CSA Senate and CSA Budget Committee minutes in addition to be emailed to current CSA Senators; and

Resolved, the CSA President will, once per term, deliver a State of the Carleton Student Association report to the College Council, which will be made public to the student body.
