## **SUBSTANCE-FREE AREA AGREEMENT**

### **Substance-Free Area Purpose**

Substance-Free Areas are those designated as a place free of alcohol, tobacco or any illegal drugs. Residents and their guests agree not to use substances while on the floor and not to cause a disruption on the floor because they used substances elsewhere.

### **Substance-Free Area Guidelines**

The possession or use of alcohol, controlled substances and tobacco products by residents or their guests is prohibited in student rooms and public spaces in Substance-Free Areas. If residents or their guests choose to use such substances outside of the Substance-Free Area, the results of that choice must not have a negative impact upon residents or property upon return to the Substance-Free Area.
