ON CAMPUS SUMMER HOUSING, 2008

Eligibility

Full-time students who have a paid position at Carleton averaging 20-hours per week during the summer are eligible to live in College housing from Sunday, June 15 to midnight on August 29. Students who are graduating are not eligible for summer housing. Please understand that spaces are limited and housing for the summer is not guaranteed. Applications for the entire summer will receive first consideration in receiving housing assignments. **Students staying for a short period of time will be housed on a space available basis and will not receive a draw number.**

Cost

Rent is \$50 per week for room only. The billing weeks begin on Saturday and end on Saturday. We cannot adjust the billings for students who are not in-residence during the entire summer (i.e., if you are planning to live in the house for three weeks, go on vacation for two weeks, and then return to the house for the remainder of the summer, you will be billed for the entire summer).

Application deadline

Applications are due in the Office of Residential Life, Sevy G10, on **Monday, May 19 at 4:00 p.m.** Applications received after May 19 will not receive a draw number and will be assigned a room only if space is available.

Rooms available for the summer

Available housing will be posted online one week prior to the application deadline.

Summer Housing Draw

Summer Housing draw numbers will be posted on our website and outside of the Office of Residential Life, Sevy G10, on Wednesday, May 21. Rooms will be drawn by you or your proxy at **8:15 a.m. on Thursday, May 22, in the Office of Residential Life, Sevy G10.** You will be able to sign up for yourself and act as a proxy for one other student to draw the same room. It should be noted that, if this is done, both students' names must have been submitted by 4:00 p.m. on Monday, May 19 and appear on the list posted on May 21. You and your Carleton summer employer must sign the application before you can sign up for a room. You may draw a room with a person you want to live with during the summer or allow another applicant to draw into the room you have selected. **At the end of draw we may need to consolidate rooms if there are rooms with vacancies.**

Special Housing Accommodations

If you have special housing accommodations, please inform the Office of Residential Life in writing by Monday, May 5.

Storage

Contact Custodial Services by Tuesday, June 10, at x4133 if you will need short-term or summer storage. You may not move any items into summer houses prior to June 15. Items stored in the summer houses prior to June 15 will be removed and delivered to the dumpster and the student responsible will be charged a hauling fee. Summer residents may not store belongings in the basement or porches for the summer.

Air conditioning

Please note that summer housing is not air-conditioned and residents may not install air-conditioners.

Commencement Housing

Students needing housing from June 10-14 will need to reserve Commencement Housing. The charge for Commencement Housing is \$100, which includes meals. See information attached regarding Commencement Housing.

Early Arrival Housing

Summer Housing will close at midnight on Friday, August 29. Please plan to move between Thursday, August 28, 4 p.m. and Friday, August 29, midnight. You may make arrangements to move to your assigned room for the 2008-2009 academic year at that time or move off campus. If you choose to move to your permanent assignment, you will be billed at a rate of \$25 per day from Saturday, August 30 until upper-class student's return.

Summer Housing Contract

Students receiving summer housing are required to sign a Summer Housing Contract, which states the conditions established to govern summer housing at Carleton. Your signature on this contract indicates your agreement to abide by these conditions. Failure to comply with the guidelines could result in removal from Carleton housing.
