

Health and Safety Information for Parents

Thank you for sharing your children with us at the Carleton College Prairie and Wood Nature Day Camp. We want to ensure that Prairie and Wood is a safe experience. We have some important information to share with you. Please read this closely, sign at the bottom, and return to a camp counselor.

1. No child may be left at the camp for whom we do not have a completed medical history form and signed waiver. No child may be transported on a field trip without a signed waiver. We won't administer prescription medication without a separate form.
2. Your children will be logged in and out of camp each day. Children may not leave the camp early, or with any adult other than the parent/guardian listed on the health form, unless you have made prior arrangements before or at the time of drop-off.
3. Please drop off and pick up your child in front of Farm House. Coming from Northfield on Hwy. 19, turn right on the gravel drive halfway up the hill from Lyman Lake. Farm House is the last structure on the right. After drop-off, continue through to the parking lot next to the Recreation Center, and to the paved drive back to Hwy 19.
4. The most dangerous part of our summer camp is getting there! Please buckle up your children in the car. Watch for children going from the parking lot to Farm House. If they are biking to camp, make sure that they are wearing a helmet, and that they are taking a route through the Carleton campus, not on busy Hwy 19.
5. In an emergency requiring transport, counselors will call 911. The camp counselors will contact you regarding all medical situations. Carleton staff may not transport campers to medical care.
6. We will notify you in the event of your child's illness or injury, if there are any 'close calls', behavioral problems that threaten the safety of your child or others, or if there is a serious incident with one of the campers. We will also notify you if we become aware of any communicable illnesses among the campers.
7. Please do your part by:
 - keeping your children home if they have a communicable illness;
 - making sure your emergency contact information is current;
 - dropping off and picking up your children on time;*
 - communicating with us about your child's special situations or needs.
