## CARLETON FOOTBALL REPORT - WEEK FOUR

### »»TODAY'S GAME -- Carleton at St. Olaf (Take 89)

Carleton College and St. Olaf College, Northfield football foes for nearly a full century, meet for the 89th official time (86th game as varsity programs) in one of college football's most unique rivals. Adding to the hoopla is the fact that it's Homecoming for the Oles.

In addition to a year's worth of bragging rights, the famed "Goat Trophy" is up for grabs for the 74th time. The Knights are trying to win back the award-- which was originally give out in 1931--for the first time since 1996. The Oles bring an 11-game winning streak over Carleton into today's showdown, the longest win streak for either school in this series. St. Olaf holds a 46-41-1 edge all-time. Prior to the current stretch of St. Olaf victories, Carleton prevailed in 10 of 11 games from 1985-96.

The Oles have only played Carleton once in a homecoming game since 1996, a 34-21 win in 2004.

Temperatures for today's game are expected to hover around 60 degrees. That makes a repeat of the blizzard that cancelled the Nov. 2, 1991 game highly unlikely.

### »»KNIGHTS RECEIVE VOTES IN NATIONAL POLL

Carleton is receiving votes in both the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) and D3football.com national polls.

This is the first time since the creation of the D3football poll in 2003 that the Knights have even received a vote. Carleton showed up in the AFCA poll on September 23, for the first time since that national poll was started in 1999. It appears that this is the first time the Knights have appeared on any national ranking since winning the conference crown in 1992.

## »»LAST TIME THESE TEAMS MET: Sept. 15, 2007

For a while it looked like an upset could be brewing as the Knights led 21-7 early in the second quarter, but the Oles ended up scoring the game's final 63 points, including 28 in the third quarter and 28 more in the fourth to pull away for the 85-28 win, the 11th straight for St. Olaf in the series.

Quarterback Shane Henfling established a Carleton mark with 33 completions. He finished the day with four touchdowns and a career-high 421 passing yards, the fourth-highest single-game total in school history. He had touchdown throws of 13, 8, and 14 yards to Matt Frank and 41 yards to R.J. Jackson.

St. Olaf quarterback Matt Penz was 20-of-30 for 407 yards and five touchdowns on the afternoon. Wide receiver Horace Gant concluded the day with six catches for 142 yards. Running back Evan Endlsey accounted for four scores on the day, and the Oles defense returned a pair of interceptions for touchdowns in the second half.

## »»THE KNIGHTS LAST WEEK: Carleton 33, Macalester 13

In what has been informally called the "Brain Bowl" for many years, Carleton College posted a 33-13 victory over visiting Macalester College in the Knights' home opener.

Quarterback Shane Henfling was 14-of-19 for 246 yards and four touchdowns in barely over two quarters of action. His primary target on the afternoon was wide receiver Chris Gardner, who had eight receptions for 180 yards and three touchdowns. The pair connected on scoring strikes of 70, 10 and 47 yards. The Knights also gained 135 yards on the ground, including 96 yards and a touchdown from first-year Jon Lien, who averaged 7.4 yards per carry.

Macalester (2-2) tried to use its ground game to keep pace with Carleton and totaled 179 rushing yards. T.Joe Loiselle led the way, carrying 27 times for 121 yards and both Scots' touchdowns. It was his third straight 100-yard contest.

Carleton scored on its first two possession, quickly taking control of the contest. On the Knights' fourth play from scrimmage, Henfling found Gardner, who eluded multiple defenders as he went 70 yards to the endzone.

## »»RAMLER AT THE HELM

Kurt Ramler is in his third year as Carleton College's head football coach. He guided the Knights to a 7-13 mark in his first two seasons, the program's highest two-season victory total since the mid 1990s. Ramler is the 16th head coach in the football program's history, which stretches more than 120 years.

Since taking over the program in February of 2006, he has led Carleton to strong performances against nationally ranked opponents. The Knights posted upset victories over Bethel University—both times by the score of 17-14—in 2006 & 2008. Last year, Ramler nearly led Carleton to its first-ever victory over Saint John's, leading the then No. 3 Johnnies until the final 56 seconds.

In addition to several seasons as a coach at the Division III level, Ramler also spent one year at NCAA Division I-AA Wagner College and coached two summers overseas in the European Federation of American Football (EFAF).

## »SHANE HENFLING & THE RECORD BOOK

Shane Henfling is 7th in the nation in pass efficiency (176.15)

He took over the starting quarterback role last year as a junior and proceeded to help rewrite the Carleton record book with one of the best seasons

ever by a Knights quarterback, accumulating 1,903 yards and 20 touchdown passes in 2007. His stats would have been even more impressive had he not missed nearly two games due to injury.

Among the many records he broke or challenged, he owns the career completion percentage mark (205-of-356, 57.6%), equaled the single-season mark (56.3% in 2007), accumulated the second-best single-season TD pass total (20 in 2007), and broke the single-game record for completions (33 in 2007).

Henfling's five touchdowns in week one matched his career high and are one shy of the school record. His 374 passing yards that day tied for the sixth-highest single-game total in program history. He now has 31 career touchdown passes, one behind Tim Nielsen for fourth on Carleton's all-time list.

## »»MATT FRANK & CHRIS GARDNER: A DYNAMIC DUO

**Matt Frank's career totals (150 receptions, 2064 yards, 18 TDs)**

**Chris Gardner's career totals (125 receptions, 2206 yards, 24 TDs)**

Both Gardner and Frank surpassed the 2,000-yard milestone during the Bethel game, joining Jim Bradford and Jeff Scherer as the only Carleton teammates to surpass 2000 yards.

In 2007, Gardner recorded 56 catches for 1,054 yards, the 12th-best total in Div-III. He hauled in 13 TD passes, equaling the school mark, and averaged 18.8 yards per reception, tops among the leading receivers in the conference. Gardner averaged 105.4 receiving yards/game, fifth in the MIAC and 14th in the nation.

Frank, an All-American in 2006 as he hauled in a school-record 74 passes, missed the first five games of the 2007 campaign with an injury sustained during training camp. He still finished second on the team with 35 receptions for 394 yards (11.3 avg) and five touchdowns.

Gardner has crossed the 100-yard mark eight times in his career, including a trio of 200-yard explosions, giving him three of the top five receiving games (yardage) in school history. Frank has recorded seven lifetime 100-yard performances.

# INSIDE THE CARLETON - ST. OLAF SERIES

•The teams played numerous times prior to 1918, the first official meeting, but the 1919 St. Olaf squad is considered its first true varsity squad.

•The 90-year-old rivalry has fostered traditions. The winning team takes home "the Goat" (as in "we got your goat"), a wooden trophy created by a St. Olaf carpenter in 1931. The back of the trophy shows the results of each game. Some years a Cereal Bowl trophy is presented by Malt-O-Meal to the winning school. Another annual tradition has fans marching to downtown Northfield, where they turn the eagle on the city's Civil War monument in Bridge Square to face the winning school.

•One of the most unique college football rivalries began 90 years ago. Carleton had fielded a varsity team since the turn of the century, but St. Olaf was just on the cusp of varsity status. In 1918, with World War I engulfing the nation and the colleges depleted of male athletes, the U.S. War Department directed the two schools to field a joint football team. They played only one game (a 59-6 loss to the University of Minnesota) before deciding it was an unhappy union and the two schools faced each other in various forms three times that same season. The next year (1919), the Oles fielded a varsity team and the rivalry was born. (For the record, Carleton won the first match-up 15-7.)

•The series has been interrupted just four times: a three-year hiatus from 1943-45 due to WWII and the canceled game during the Halloween snowstorm of 1991, when over 25 inches of snow hit southern Minnesota. [A sidenote here: former Carleton head coach Bob Sullivan swears that he had the Metrodome booked for the game, but St. Olaf wasn't too interested in playing the favored Knights.]

•The Goat Trophy is slightly younger than the rivalry itself. Competition for the travelling trophy began in 1931; a local men's clothing store, The Toggery, provided it to complement the original basketball Goat Trophy exchange that began during the 1913-14 season. The Oles took home the Goat Trophy after that first game, a 25-6 victory.

•The "Liter Bowl" gave the series a unique twist in 1977. The squads tried to usher in the metric system; the playing field was extended nine yards to reach 100 meters in length, and the players were listed in centimeters and kilograms in the game program. The brainchild of Carleton chemistry professor Jerry Mohrig, the game attracted 10,000 fans and attention from the national media, including Sports Illustrated, The New York Times, Chicago Tribune and NBC Television. St. Olaf handily won the contest, 43-0. It is the only NCAA-sanctioned football game to have been played on a metric field.

•The series garnered national attention five years ago at the College Football Hall of Fame. A display on rivalries featured a quote from prominent sports-writer Dan Jenkins: "National championships, titles, trophies, jugs, mugs and hugs – all of these are things that make up the game's traditional rivalries. It doesn't matter if it's USC vs. UCLA or hundreds of St. Olafs taking on hundreds of Carletons, for what is on display is the essence of a sport."

•The game is known for close contests: Five of the last 17 meetings have been decided by a touchdown or less. The Oles won the 1997 contest 14-12, ending a seven-year losing streak to the Knights. In the 88 previous meetings (since 1918) between the two teams, 28 have been decided by seven points or less.
