


## Option 3: Long Term Registration via Phone

*Guest sign-up via email or SMS*

1. Select *Guest signup via email or SMS*.



3. Enter your email address, then click **Submit**.




4. You should receive a text within one minute.

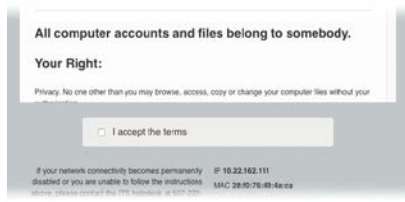

There are three options for registering on our network, depending on your particular needs. Those options are outlined on the next pages

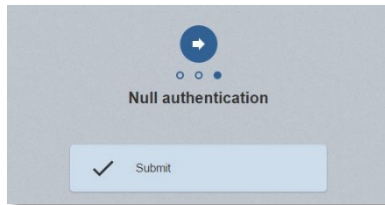
## Option 1: Quick 5-Day Registration

### *Temporary Access without registration*

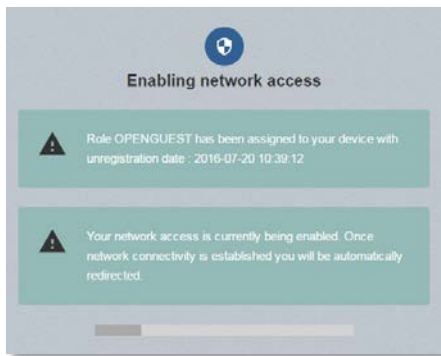
1. Select *Temporary access without registration*.
2. The following usage agreement will appear. Scroll down and select “I accept the terms” checkbox.



3. Click on the **Submit** button.



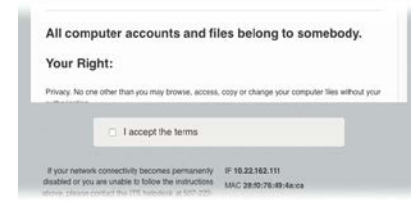
4. Your network access will now be enabled. This will take a few moments, during which the following screen will appear.



## Option 2: Long Term Registration via Google

### *Sign in with Google (non-Carleton)*

1. Select *Sign in with Google (non-Carleton)*.
2. The following usage agreement will appear. Scroll down and select “I accept the terms” checkbox.



3. Click on the **Login** button.



4. You will now be taken to Google's login pages. Login as normal using your personal (non-Carleton) Google account. *Please note, Carleton will not receive any of your personal Google account information as a result of this process.*
5. *Your network access will now be enabled. This will take a few moments, during which the following screen will appear*
