

# Greek Polytonic Keyboard (Macintosh)

Mac OS 10.5

This document shows the available characters on the Greek Polytonic keyboard layout that is built into the Macintosh OS.

## *Dead Keys (highlighted in orange)*

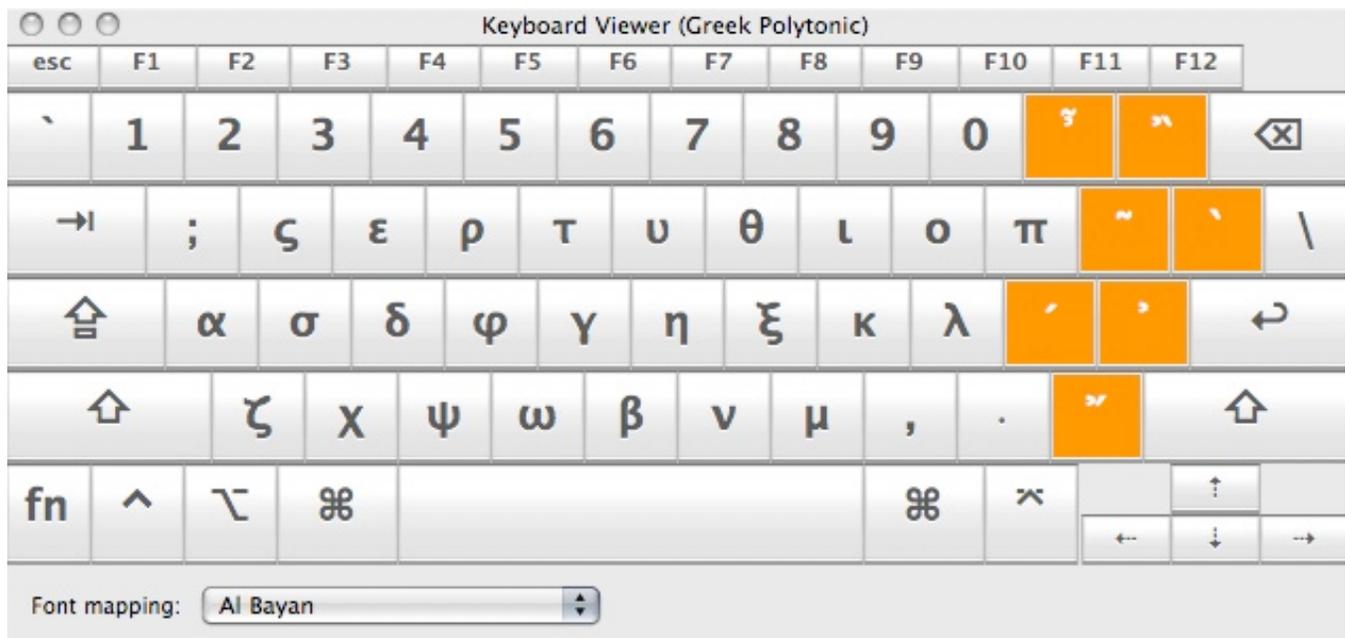
To add diacritics to characters, this keyboard uses dead keys. To add a diacritic to a character, first press the necessary key for the diacritic, release that key and then type the base character.

e.g. for  $\acute{\alpha}$  type ; [release] a

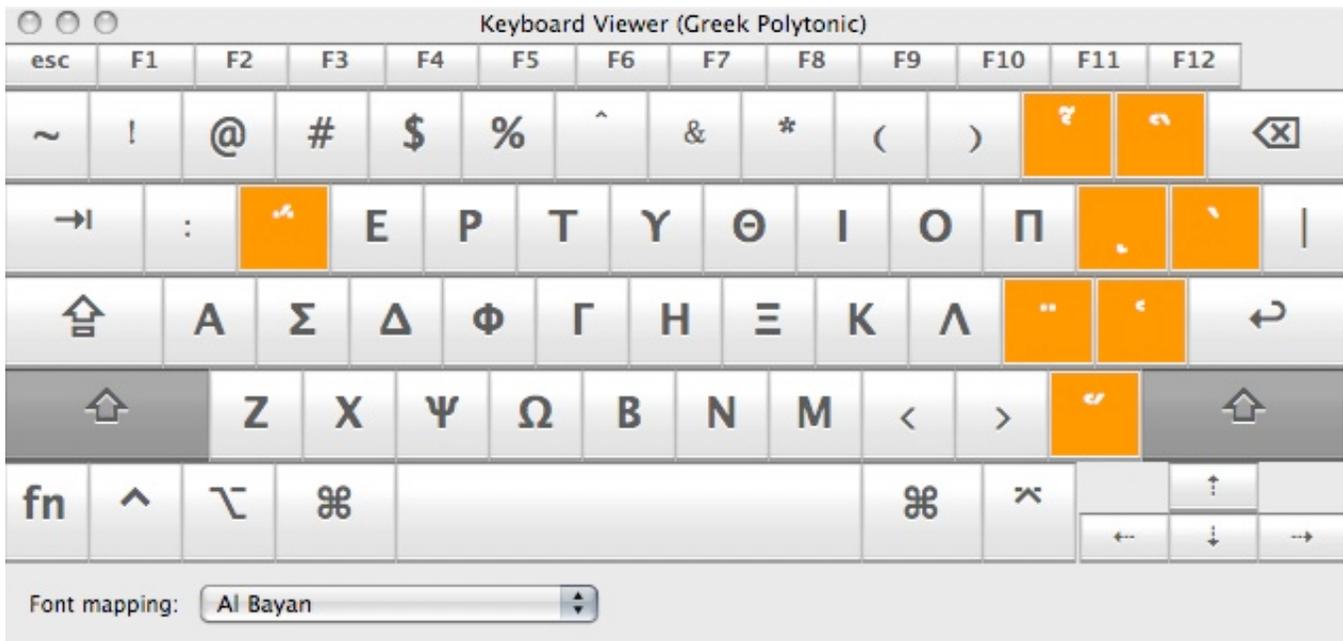
## *Graphical Layout*

Below are graphical layouts of the different states of the keyboard. Each keyboard state is labeled by the necessary modifier key (Shift, Option, etc) held down to create that state.

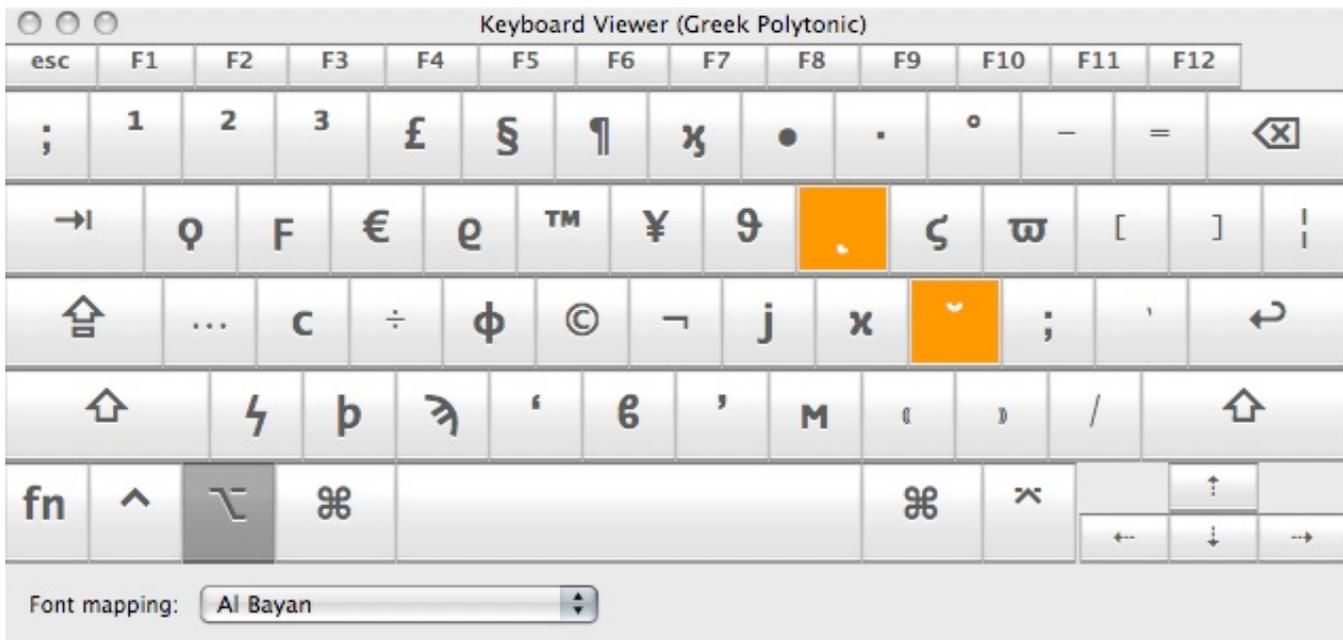
### *Natural State (no shift or other modifier keys)*
